Index and Citations Research Publisher, Index and Research Academic Researcher, Best Research Book and Book Chapter Publisher, Best Creative Publisher, Department with Most Citations Publications, Best Department for Research Contribution, as well as the once-in-a-lifetime Gold Award for Outstanding Researcher Awards, prizes and certificates will be awarded through nine channels.

The National Research Conference will be held on the theme. For that, about seventy (70) research papers representing different universities and higher education institutes in Sri Lanka, to be conducted physically and online in archaeology, heritage management and history, environmental management, geography and development studies, language, culture and literature, technological innovation. And research papers are to be presented in a number of fields including education, economy, governance and schools, communication and mass media, social science and humanities, and tourism. All these academic activities are expected to make the Faculty of Sociology and Humanities a hub of Sri Lankan research as well as new knowledge production.
